- 1- 5 gallon kool-aid mix

### Your choice of 2:

- 1 - can of hominy
- 1 - can of corn
- 1 - can of potatoes
- 1 - can of jalapenos
- 1 - can of mixed vegetables
- 1 - can of mixed fruit

\*All of the items listed above are staples of the Mexican diet and needed on a regular basis

## Hygiene Bags \*Additional Supplies Needed for Special Needs

### Items Needed:

- 1 - shampoo
- 1 - conditioner
- 1 - deodorant (men/women)
- 1 - toothpaste
- 1 - toothbrushes (variety)
- 3 - bars of soap
- 5 - band aids (individual)
- 5 - q-tips ( individual)
- 1 - razor (men/women)
- 1 - bottle of aspirin
- 1 - hairbrush/combs
- 2 - hair ties
- 3 - feminine pads ( individual)

We’ve found these to be an aid to making sure families keep up with bodily hygiene and also helping take some of the continual cost off the shoulders of the parents.
